Rationale

ICRA has withdrawn the ratings for pass through certificates (PTCs) issued under securitisation transaction backed by microfinance loans receivables originated by Spandana Sphoorty Financial Limited (SSFL) (SSFL/Originator; rated [ICRA]A- (Negative)) as tabulated above. All the payouts to the investor(s) in the above-mentioned instrument has been made and no further payments are due to the investor(s).

About the Originator

Spandana Sphoorty Financial Limited (SSFL) was incorporated in 2003 as a non-banking financial company (NBFC) and it took over the microfinance operations of Spandana, a non-Governmental organisation started by Ms. Padmaja Reddy in 1998. The company was classified as an NBFC-microfinance institution (NBFC-MFI) in 2015. Following the microfinance crisis in Andhra Pradesh (AP), the company entered into a master restructuring agreement (MRA) as a part of the corporate debt restructuring (CDR) with its lenders in September 2011. It exited the CDR in April 2017 after an equity investment led by Kedaara Capital Investment Managers Limited (Kedaara Capital) and fresh funding from three banks. SSFL completed its initial public offering (IPO) in August 2019. The company has a 9-member board of directors, including five independent directors.

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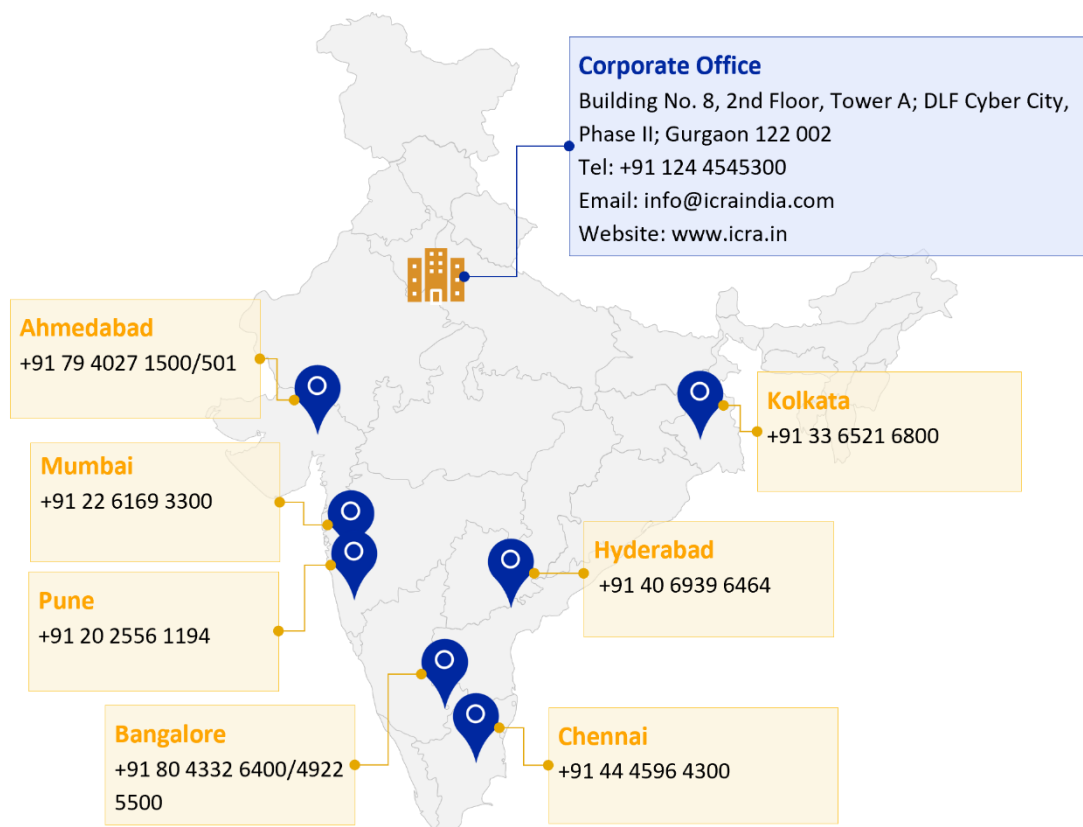


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
