Rationale

ICRA has kept the Long-Term and Short-Term ratings of Aarey Drugs & Pharmaceuticals Limited in the 'Issuer Not Cooperating' category. The ratings are denoted as "[ICRA]B+(Stable); ISSUER NOT COOPERATING/[ICRA]A4; ISSUER NOT COOPERATING".

As part of its process and in accordance with its rating agreement with Aarey Drugs & Pharmaceuticals Limited, ICRA has been trying to seek information from the entity so as to monitor its performance. Further, ICRA has been sending repeated reminders to the entity for payment of surveillance fee that became due. Despite multiple requests by ICRA, the entity's management has remained non-cooperative. In the absence of requisite information and in line with the aforesaid policy of ICRA, the rating has been continued to the "Issuer Not Cooperating" category. The rating is based on the best available information.

About the company

ADPL was incorporated in the year 1990 as a private limited company in the name of Niharika Textiles & Chemicals Private Limited. In 1993, the Aarey Group, owned by Ghatalia Family, took over the company and renamed it to Aarey Drugs & Pharmaceuticals Limited. During the same year, the company was converted into a public limited company with the shares being listed on the BSE. The company was engaged in the business of manufacturing and trading of chemical products, solvents and drug intermediaries till 2009. From 2009, the company's plant at Tarapur had remained shut for upgradation-cum expansion; the company has been focusing only on trading of chemical products, solvents and drug intermediaries since then. However, the company has obtained all the requisite approvals for the upgraded plant and has resumed operations from September 2016.

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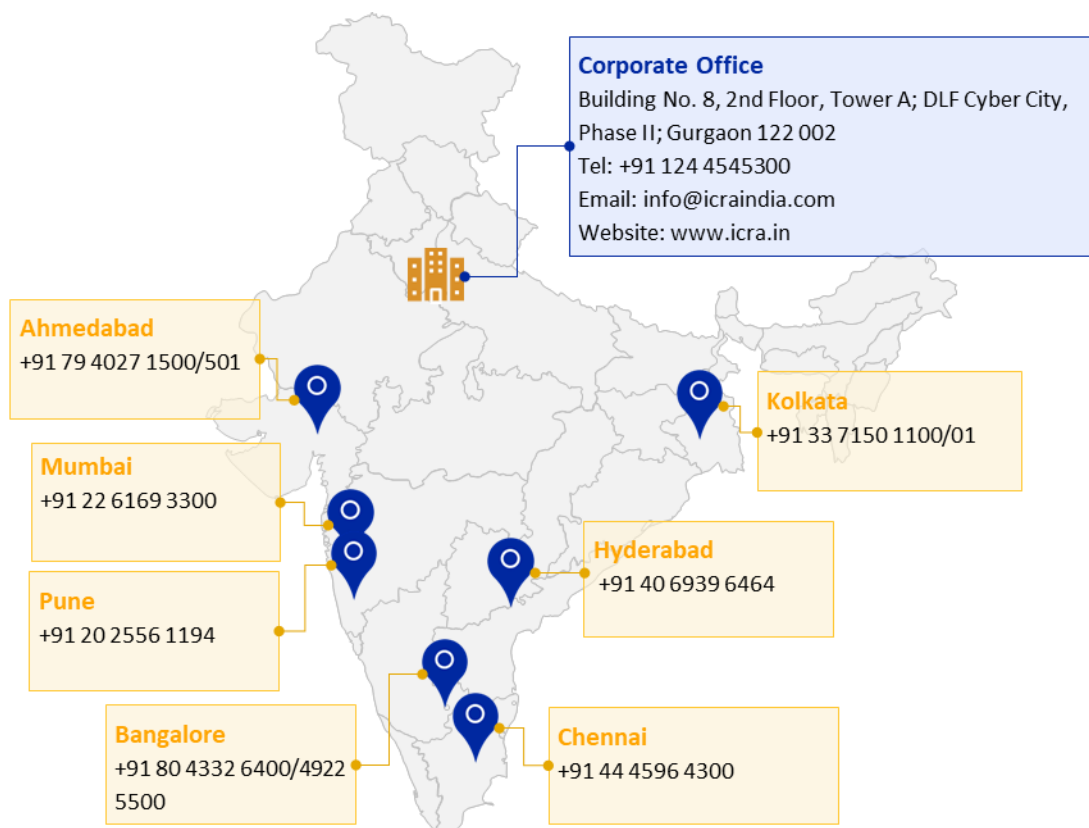
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
