Rationale

ICRA has kept the Long-Term rating of Good Shepherd Educational Trust (Good Shepherd International School) in the 'Issuer Not Cooperating' category. The rating is denoted as "[ICRA]B+(Stable); ISSUER NOT COOPERATING".

The rating continues to remain under "Issuer Not Cooperating" is because of lack of adequate information regarding Good Shepherd Educational Trust (Good Shepherd International School)'s performance and hence the uncertainty around its credit risk. ICRA assesses whether the information available about the entity is commensurate with its rating and reviews the same as per its "Policy in respect of non-cooperation by a rated entity" available at www.icra.in. The lenders, investors and other market participants are thus advised to exercise appropriate caution while using this rating as the rating may not adequately reflect the credit risk profile of the entity.

As part of its process and in accordance with its rating agreement with Good Shepherd Educational Trust (Good Shepherd International School), ICRA has been trying to seek information from the entity so as to monitor its performance further, ICRA has been sending repeated reminders to the entity for payment of surveillance fee that became due. Despite multiple requests by ICRA, the entity's management has remained non-cooperative. In the absence of requisite information and in line with the aforesaid policy of ICRA, the rating has been continued to the "Issuer Not Cooperating" category. The rating is based on the best available information.

About the company

GSIS, run by the Good Shepherd Educational Trust, is a school established in 1977. The trust runs the single entity which operates out of two campuses. Presently, the fern hill campus is closed, and operations have shifted completely to Palada campus. The trust is in talks with various buyers to monetise the fern hill campus. The school is fully residential with dorms for students and apartments for teaching and non-teaching staff. The school has 548 students as on date and wards (about 18) of the teaching and other staff members also study in this school. The school is run by the trustees Mr. Jacob Thomas (son of Late Dr. P. C. Thomas, who passed away in June 2020) and his mother, Mrs. Elsamma Thomas. The school has employed 138 teaching staff with various qualifications and has a healthy student-teacher ratio of 4.0:1 as on date. GSIS offers 1) ICSE/ISC of the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination, and 2) The Cambridge IGCSE curriculum of the University of Cambridge International Examinations, United Kingdom till the secondary level and offers IB/ The Diploma Programme of the International Baccalaureate Organisation, Geneva at the secondary level.

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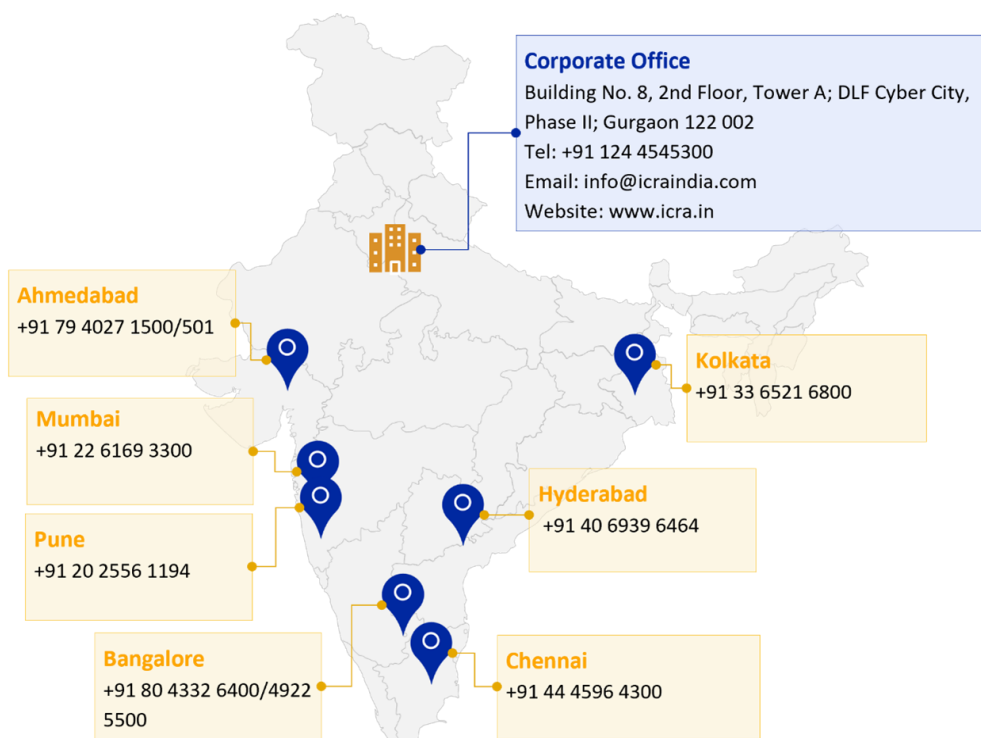


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
